- Received 2009 NCAA State Farm Coaches' All-America honorable mention.
- Tabbed as a 2009 WBCA All-District I Selection and a 2008-09 Wooden Award Finalist.
- Listed on the 2008-09 Mid-Season Naismith Award Watch List and voted onto the final ballot for the John R. Wooden Award.
- Named the 2009 Atlantic 10 Conference Player of the Year
- Tabbed the 2008 Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Year.
- Earned 2008 Atlantic 10 Championship Most Outstanding Player honors.

College Notes

- As a sophomore in 2008-09, started in all 32 games played and led the team in scoring (13.0 ppg.), rebounding (12.1 rpg.), and field goal percentage (61.3 percent) to help Xavier to a 25-7 record and an NCAA Tournament appearance.
- Finished fourth in the country in both rebounds per game (12.1) and field goal percentage (.613%).
- Hauled in a Xavier record 386 boards during 2008-09 to break the mark she established (371) during her freshman year.
- Finished second in the conference in blocks per game (1.7).
- Has notched 34 career double-doubles and scored in double-figures in 45 of XU's last 53 games.
- Recorded 16 double-doubles and scored in double-figures 23 times.
- Her 25-rebound effort at North Carolina, set a school record and tied Sean May's Dean Dome record.
- Her 54 blocks marked the third-highest single-season total in school history.
- As a freshman in 2007-08, started in 32 of 33 games played, and averaged 14.0 ppg. and league leading marks of 4.3 offensive rpg. and 6.9 defensive rpg. to help Xavier to a 24-9 record.
- Grabbed a then-school single-season record 371 rebounds.
- Her 463 points were the third-most ever scored by a Xavier freshman.
- The second-best field goal percentage (.594%) in the Atlantic 10; also the sixth best single-season percentage in Xavier history.
- Finished 12th in the league in blocks per game with 35, the seventh-highest single-season total in school history.
- Scored in double-figures 25 times and corralled at least 10 rebounds on 22 occasions.
- Scored 20 or more points on five occasions.
- Led the league with 18 double-doubles, the most by any freshman in the country.

High School Honors

- Selected as a member of the McDonald's All-American Team and as Indiana's "Miss Basketball" following her senior season.
- A *Parade* All-America second team honoree in 2007 and a third team selection following both the 2005 and 2005 campaigns.
- Earned *USA Today's* All-USA first team in 2007.
- The 2007 Indiana Gatorade Player of the Year.
- Honored as an all-area pick in 2005, 2006 and 2007.

High School Notes

- As a senior in 2006-07, averaged 21.6 ppg., 15.3 rpg. and 3.2 bpg. while shooting 75.4 percent from the floor during her senior season at Brebeuf Jesuit.
- Finished her prep career with 1,939 points and 1,308 rebounds.
- Led the squad to the Class 3A State Championship in 2004 and 2007.
